***Requirements for texts:***

Up to 10 pages, typed in Times New Roman 14, single line spacing. References should be made and numbered as footnotes on each page. Page margins: top and bottom – 20 mm, left – 30 mm, right – 10 mm. On the first line, align right – the author's full name; on the second – name of your institution; third line, align center – the title of your report (lowercase bold), then leaving one empty line – text of the report.
