**«The “Bagration” Operation (for the 75th anniversary of the liberation of Belarus from Nazi occupation)»**

Conference time: June 27 – 28, 2019.

Conference place: Institute of History of the National academy of sciences of Belarus, Minsk, Belarus.

***The conference will focus on the following issues:***

- Modern accesses of denotation stages of the liberation of Belarus from Nazi occupation during the Great Patriotic war: Historiography and Source Study aspects.
- Surazh (Vitebsk) “gates”: the first attempt of the liberation of the territory of Belarus (February – September, 1942).
- Red Army offensives in Autumn, 1943 – Spring, 1944: first phase of the final liberation of Belarus.
- “Bagration” Belarusian strategic offensive operation and final liberation of the territory of Belarus: June, 23 – July, 28, 1944.
- Soviet military art during the Great Patriotic war.
- Belorussian military feats on the forefront: personal heroism and commander’s talent.
- Nazi occupation regime on the territory of Belarus (1941 – 1944).
- Confessional situation in Belarus during the Great Patriotic war.
- Soviet partisan resistance and underground activities in the territory of Belarus (1941 – 1944).
- Belarus sons in partisan resistance of other Soviet republics and European Resistance.
- Soviet republics’ representatives and foreign anti-fascists in Belorussian Soviet partisan resistance.
- Military community of Belorussian, Russian, Ukraine, Moldavian, Latvian, Lithuanian partisan squads.
- Combat interaction: Red Army units and Belorussian partisan detachments.
- Anti-Soviet armed forces in Belarus during the Great Patriotic war and early postwar years (1943 – 1950th).
- Belorussians in the Soviet rear.
- The post-occupation period of war in Belarus (Autumn, 1943 – Spring, 1945): restoration labour, daily routine.
- The Great Patriotic war events, heros and victims’ memory in Belarus.
- The Great Patriotic war history in educational process: school, college, university.

Time-limit: plenary reports – 20 min, section reports – 15 min.

The conference working languages: Belarusian, Russian, English.

Conference texts compilation will be published after the conference.

Submit your applications and texts until June 10, 2019. Please specify in your application: your name (names), academic degree and position, your working affiliation, the title of your report, your postal address, phone, e-mail, necessity of booking a hotel, and multimedia (if need).

Requirements for texts: up to 20 thousand signs typed in Times New Roman 14, one-and-a-half spacing, 1,25 indentation. Page margins: 20 mm. Typography: links patterned by Higher Attestation Commission and without page numbers. File format: doc, docx, rtf.
