## THE UNION OF LUBLIN AND THE SITUATION IN EASTERN EUROPE - 450 YEARS LATER

The Union of Lublin is often referred to as the first attempt to create a federalist Union of European States in Europe, based on the election of governing bodies and the close interpenetration of economies. That is why, some researchers tend to consider the year of 1569 as the beginning of attempts of European integration, which came to its natural outcome in the twentieth century with the creation of the EU. Today, the European Union is probably the most advanced form of integration on the continent and in the world. Nevertheless, it is necessary to understand that the conclusion of the Lublin Union is quite a controversial process, which was accompanied by a serious political struggle. However, the emerged state of Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth could not resist the attempts of the three neighboring empires to divide and absorb it.

Today, two of the four countries that made up The Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth are part of the EU, two are at its borders, while Ukraine is committed to membership in the European Union, Belarus only has relations of a good neighbor. At the same time, the tangle of relations between Belarus, Poland, Lithuania and Ukraine looks very contradictory and ambiguous, and it is difficult to talk about the presence of any federalist attitude or even more prospects between them.

The conference will bring together experts from Belarus, Poland, Lithuania, Ukraine.

This conference aims at:

- detailed historical and political analysis of the existing heritage in relations between the countries of the former Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth,
  - current situation between these countries
  - possible prospects for its development.
