Working languages: Russian, Belarusian, English

**Terms of application: deadline of application is May 20, 2024.** The title of the report, name, scientific position of the author(s), institution, contact address(es), phone number(s), e-mail, information on multimedia necessity should be specified.

**Conference proceedings** will be published in the annual issue "Aktual'nye voprosy antropologii". Digital (\*.doc or \*.rtf documents) and two paper copies of the article should be delivered in Russian (Belarusian) or English language. The article should be performed according to the next rules: <u>Volume</u> – up to 10 pages, <u>Font</u> – Times New Roman, <u>Font size</u> – 14 points (12 points for Russian (Belarusian) summary, key words, titles of pictures and tables, table contents), <u>Interval</u> – unary. Paragraph indentation – 1 cm. Fields: upper – 2, lower – 2, left – 2, right – 2. The summary of 250-300 words with subsections (Introduction with the purpose of the research, Materials and Methods, Results, Conclusions) in the beginning of the text should be in Russian (Belarusian), at the end of the text – in English. Key words in Russian (Belarusian) and English languages after the summary. The main text (preferably) should include the next subheads: *Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusions, Literature*. <u>References</u> in the text should be given in square brackets; the list of literature sources grouped according to the alphabet. The pictures and another graphic objects – only black-white (gray gradations) – obligatory included in the article file (tif. format, quality 600 dpi). The number according to Universal Decimal classification should be assigned to the article. **Deadline: October 1, 2024.** 

The Organizing Committee is authorized to choose the papers to perform in the conference and the articles to be published.

Travel expenses, meals and accommodation reimbursement are at the expenses of the delegating organizations.
